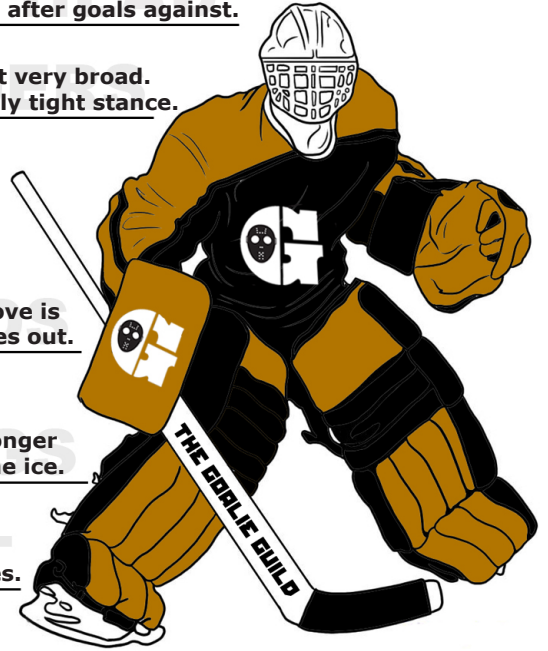
His shoulders are square, but not very broad.

## Fantasy Analysis and Goalie Skill Rankings

Delmas has quick foot, hand and lateral speed. But his butterfly is so tight that a lot of space just inside the posts (hips up) are exposed. His leg pads are worn so loose that the thigh rises overlap. That makes him look even smaller while making a save, although his five-hole coverage is almost elite because of it. Delmas plays too deep in his crease to be effective at the pro level; his skates land right on top of the blue crease, which means he needs to take two steps out. Delmas also struggles with setting his feet. As a shot is taken, they slightly flare out, which causes bad rebounds and somewhat delayed reactions. He also needs to work on taking away time and space on shooters coming out of the corners. Instead of pushing laterally, he needs to push out and take away time and space.
